Take A421 ramp to MK south/Buckingham/M1. 6. At roundabout, take 3rd exit onto Grafton Street/V6/A421. 7. At roundabout, take 3rd exit onto Standing Way/H8/A421. 8. At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Fleming Drive. 9. At roundabout, take 2nd exit leading to A&E.
