PARENTAL CODE OF CONDUCT 2020/21

- 1. Do not force your child to train or play, especially if they do not want to take part in sporting activities.
- 2. Do not forget that the children take part in Football for their own enjoyment, not yours.
- 3. Encourage your child to always play by the rules.
- **4.** Help your child to understand that 100% effort is as important as victory. This will help them to accept results without undue disappointment.
- **5.** Turn a defeat in to a positive thing by helping your child to improve their abilities and develop their team and sporting spirit. Do not ridicule or get angry at your child if they make a mistake or their side lose a game.
- **6.** The best way for a child to learn, is to follow the adult's example. Acknowledge a game was well played, whether by your child's team or their opponents.
- **7.** Do not argue in public with the decisions taken by the officials. Do not doubt their fairness or be abusive towards them.
- **8.** Recognize the value and importance of the voluntary coaches. They give their time and efforts freely to enable your child to enjoy their football.
- **9.** Be supportive of your child's Managers/Coaches and the other Club officials, and recognize the work they put in so that the Club can function.
- **10.** Do not approach the Manager/Coaches directly with any issues after a game. All matters should be discussed with the team Manager/Coach 24 hours after the game.
- **11.** All team coaching of tactics, be it in training or in match situations, is to only be done by the Team Manager/Coaches, not by parents or family/friends watching. This way the team players will not become confused or upset if being given conflicting instructions. The parent's role is only to encourage and support the team players.
- 12. The behavioural and discipline management of the team during training and match days, will be governed by the Team Managers/Coaches. If a situation arises, it will be discussed and agreed with the parents. It is understood and acknowledged by the Club that the child will always listen and take instructions from the parents first and foremost.

- **13.** Please volunteer to help out at all of your child's games, whether it be setting up or breaking down the goals, respect barriers or corner flags. This applies equally to all age groups.
- 14. Be aware of the Club's rules and constitution and the discipline and child protection procedures. Be supportive of these initiatives they may help answer many of your questions. Copies of any of the documents can be obtained from the Club website ww-fc.co.uk

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Team organisers are only responsible for the personal safety and well-being of individual members during Match or Training session times. Once a child leaves the Playing/Training area – Whether it is Astroturf or grass – they are no longer the responsibility of the Club officers, the responsibility then returns to the parent/guardian.
- It is VERY IMPORTANT that you arrive and then collect your child at the correct times on Match days and Training sessions.
- Any Match kit provided is the property of WWFC and, should your child leave the Club, the Match kit must be returned to their manager for re-use. If you are unable to return the kit, you agree to pay a (nominal) replacement charge of £50.
- During the playing season concerned NO CHILD will be registered as members of the Club UNTIL their initial membership fee payment has been made. All subsequent payments must be made by using the Club registration software, and be pre authorised. This software is currently LoveAdmin.
- As parent/guardian, you will be expected to support the Club procedures and policies.
- You agree that your email address can be used to send email communications about club events and initiatives. Your email address will not be passed to anyone outside of the Club.

Woburn & Wavendon FC is organised on a purely voluntary basis. We cannot function unless parents are willing to play their part in helping to run the Club for the children. When enrolling your child to play for the Club, you are joining as a member too. This means you will potentially be asked to give up three hours each year to help with various fund raising events (e.g. Club football tournaments). By signing this membership form, you agree to help out when asked and if possible. Without your help fundraising, the Club will not be able to continue offering the services it does to all children belonging to it. Please be assured, we are always grateful for any support and assistance you can offer.

MEMBERSHIP SUBSCRIPTIONS FOR THE 2020/21 SEASON

All payments are managed through our Club Registration Software – currently LoveAdmin

Initial membership fee of £35 is due on registration. The remaining fees are not due until 1st September 2020. The club reserves the right to change the fees up to the 1st August.

The current fees are - U7 to U11- £175 & U12 to Adult - £200 (these amounts include the £35 Initial membership fee payment due upon registration). Should you wish to pay in instalments, the first instalment will commence from 1st September (or following month for mid season starters). This includes winter training at the Power League or equivalent between the times of 6pm & 8pm for one hour per week.

There is a £30 reduction in fees for an additional child, and all additional siblings after the first, a £20 reduction is applied when signing on up to and including October. 'Flexi Player' membership is exempt from this discount. Applying these discounts, please ensure you click on the sibling membership for the 2nd and subsequent child. The first child should be standard membership.

The fees also include a full training kit or tracksuit top (as decided by your team manager) - only when registering with the club as a new Member before February 2020.

We also include twice monthly Pro Coaching during the winter sessions (U7-U11) and Referee fee's for U12 – Adult.

Payment of Club Membership fees:

- **A).** Overdue by one month non-payment then payment must be brought up to date as soon as possible and before the next date of payment.
- **B).** Overdue by two consecutive month's non-payment immediate suspension of all Club activities until the account is brought up to date.
- C). Overdue by three consecutive month's non-payment Membership is annulled
